

Apple TV Set-Up



To make your **Apple TV** work with a projector, you will need:

Apple TV with **Power Cord** and **Remote**, and an **HDMI to VGA Converter**



Plug in the **Apple TV** to power and then connect the **HDMI to VGA Converter**. Next, plug the VGA cable into the other end of the Converter and connect to a projector.



The following screens will automatically appear.

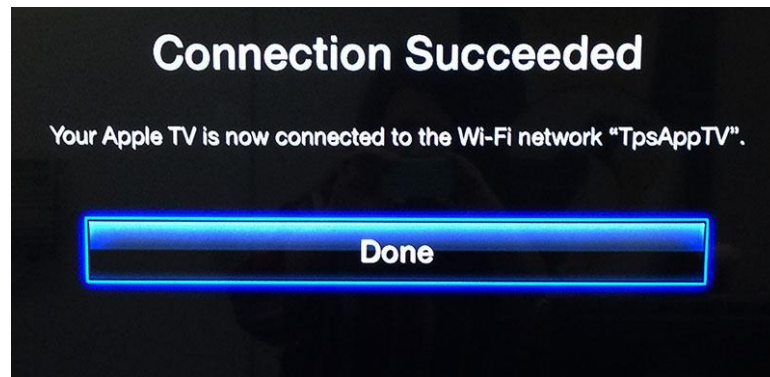
Select English

Click Done



(If an error message appears saying you cannot connect to the network, you may have to use a network cable and plug your Apple TV into a data jack the first time you use it. Once the Apple TV goes to the home screen you can unplug the Network Cable.)

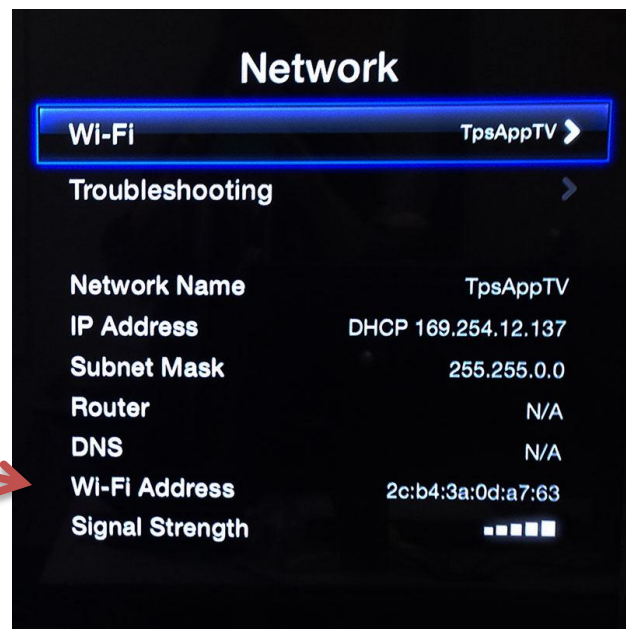
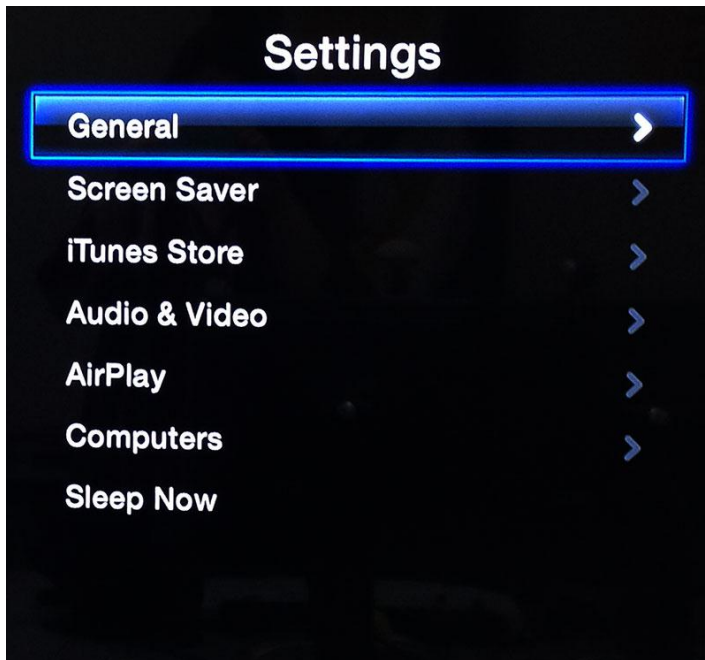
Finding the MAC Address (Wi-Fi Address)

The **Home Screen** will appear. Using the Remote, go to **Settings**

Click the **MENU** button on the remote 3 times to return to the **Home Screen**.

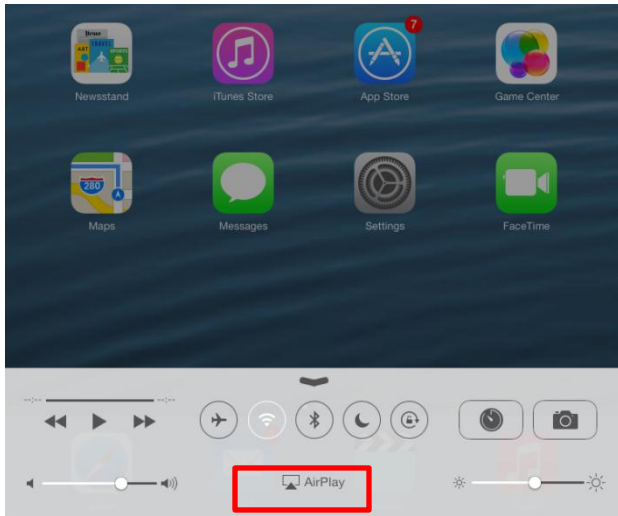
Linda Drink will add your **AppleTV** to the TPS Server. When it is ready, she will send an email saying that the device is ready to use.

Once your **Apple TV** is ready, displaying your iPad on your Whiteboard can be accomplished by following the steps below.

On the iPad/iPhone:

From the bottom of the screen, swipe up on the iPad to reveal the **Control Center**:

Click on **AirPlay**



Choose **Apple TV** Turn **Mirroring On**



Your iPad should now be displayed on your whiteboard (through your projector).
